As in the past, NBRI will be the venue of this four-day international scientific meet.

A number of prestigious international organizations like UNESCO, IUBS, TWAS, NAM S&T Centre, UNEP, COSTED, and Government of India departments like CSIR, DST, DBT, MoEF and Indian National Science Academy had co-sponsored some of these conferences in the past.

An International Advisory Committee comprising of highly distinguished environmental and plant scientists, has been constituted to guide and advise the organizers in planning and organizing this Conference.




